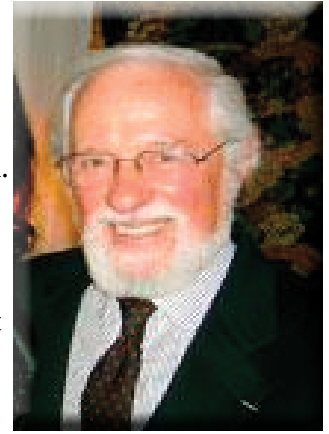

In his corporate life, he lectured at Harvard Business School, the Woodrow Wilson School at Princeton and at many institutions abroad. He has been a member of Santa Barbara's Cosmopolitan Club, University Club, a member of the board and President of the Santa Barbara Opera, the La Cumbre Country Club, and many other organizations. Sidon has been awarded two knighthoods by the French government; *The Order of Arts and Letters* and the *The Order of National Merit*. He also participated as faculty in the first three Davos Symposiums (now known as The World Economic Forum.)
