BIOGRAPHY: *Dr. Tremper Longman III* is the Robert H. Gundry Professor of Biblical Studies at Westmont College. He has written over 30 books including commentaries on Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, Song of Songs, Jeremiah, Lamentations, Daniel, and Nahum. His book *How to Read Exodus* is part of a series of books written for InterVarsity Press. His books have been translated into 17 different languages. He has edited and contributed to a number of Study Bibles and Bible Dictionaries. His most recent book (with physicist Richard Carlson) is *Science, Creation and the Bible*. Dr. Longman has a B.A. from Ohio Wesleyan University; M.Div. Westminster Theological Seminary; M.Phil. and Ph.D. Yale University.



Tremper and his wife Alice have three sons and two granddaughters. This will be Tremper's fifth year giving a seminar for VISTAS. He is a renowned biblical scholar and travels the world as a biblical expert. He speaks Hebrew and has translated the Old Testament.
