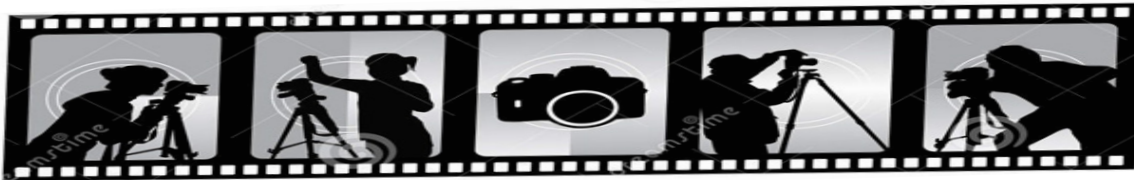

Our discussions begin with the question, "What did the film's creator want us to conclude?" Background material, including fact checking, sources of financing, opposing points of view, and notes from reviews, is presented when appropriate. We occasionally have filmmakers come to speak and show their work.

Films shown in 2015–16 included "Resistance—Not All Germs Are Created Equal," "Olmsted and America's Urban Parks," "Climate Refugees," "Hollywood—An Empire of Their Own," "MISS Representation," "Project Nim," "Codebreaker," "The Tillman Story," "Plastic Paradise: The Great Pacific Garbage Patch," and "The Fog of War."

Films tentatively scheduled for 2016–2017 are on the calendar on the back of this flyer. Other films being considered for winter and spring 2017 include the following: *Man on Wire* by Philippe Petit, *Last Train Home* by Zhang Changhua, *Seymour: An Introduction* by Ethan Hawke, and *Alexander Calder* by Roger Sherman."
