Once a year, the Santa Barbara City College faculty chooses a distinguished colleague to deliver an address on a scholarly subject of general interest.

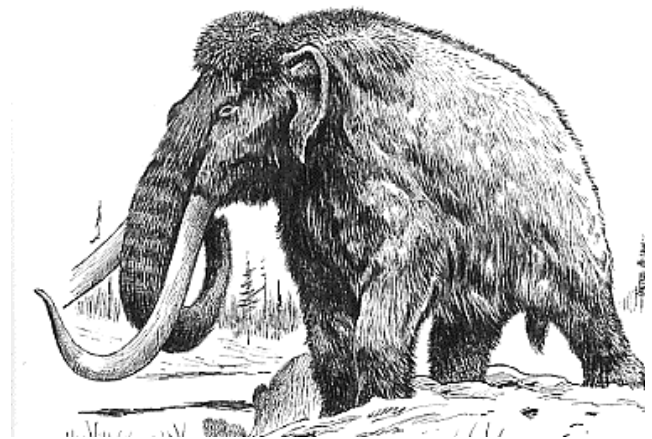
Back in 1987 our own Dr. George Frakes was so chosen. Dr. Robert S. Gray of the Geology Department has done extensive research on the paleontology of our Channel Islands and other southern California sites. Dr. Gray has graciously consented to repeat his lecture for a one-time VISTAS special session.

Besides being honored by the faculty and students at SBCC, Dr. Gray recently received the highest national award from his colleagues in the profession of geology throughout the US. Prior to joining the faculty at SBCC, Dr. Gray worked for several years as an industrial petroleum geologist and field mapping geologist. He is also a decorated retired US Navy Reserve officer.
