We’ll discuss a number of factors that affect our life experiences, such as the relations between healthcare and both financial status and geographical location; the benefits that result from becoming actively engaged in the medical decision making process; practices that can improve safety for hospitalized patients; how home healthcare and family support can affect outcomes; a look at gun violence, suicides, and mortality rates; and prescriptions for a healthy future.
