Lotusland, the 37-acre Montecito estate of the late Madame Ganna Walska, is, since her death in 1984, a living museum of gardens run by the Ganna Walska Foundation (a non-profit organization). The estate was purchased by Madame Walska in 1941 when she fell in love with California. During her ownership, Mme Walska improved upon existing gardens and created new landscapes that comprise the present unusual and exotic collections at Lotusland.

In creating the gardens, the artistic Mme Walska experimented with bold forms and unique concepts and color combinations. She contrasted serene, traditional vistas with daring, theatrical displays. A series or 13 unique gardens are presented to the strolling visitor through gateways and "doors" into the next garden.

She employed some of Santa Barbara's best landscape designers of the times, such as Lockwood de Forest and Ralph Stevens, to implement her own ideas in the gardens. She literally spent millions of dollars to design and install rare specimens to create her stunning gardens.

During a one-hour presentation of the history of the gardens and of Madame, herself, visitors will learn about Madame's background, her passion for music, her love of her Montecito property and her six husbands (each one richer than his predecessor). After the presentation we will have a short refreshment break and then divide into small groups to tour the gardens. The paths are generally flat and smooth but some are gravel and there will be lots of walking and a few steps involved.

Parking is limited so carpooling is encouraged.
