**BIOGRAPHY:** *Gerry Bonetto* is the Vice President for Government Affairs of the Printing Industries Association of California and responsible for the industry's relationships with state government in Sacramento. He is a PhD in Political Science from Claremont Graduate University, a lecturer in Political Science at California State University, Los Angeles, and co-author, with Ted, of *Governing California in the 21st Century* (Norton, 2015), now being prepared for its sixth edition.
