## *Preparing the Presenter 2015*

### *An Introduction to Course Design and Session Presentation Issues*



The Curriculum Committee is offering this free one-time session to encourage members to become active presenters by sharing with them some tools and strategies for developing successful presentations and courses.

This course consists of two parts. In the first half to two-thirds of the session, the four presenters will discuss how to select a topic, the Vistas audience, sources of information, how to organize your course, what organizational options have been used in past Vistas courses, considerations involved if you are presenting a one-time session (one-half to one hour), audio/visual/PowerPoint considerations.

The panel encourages questions and comments from the audience on these topics.

In the last half or third of the session, Ted will illustrate his approach to using PowerPoint, providing some handouts on typical PowerPoint situations and how to handle them. Each year when presenting this course, a different Vistas PowerPoint user will present his or her approach.
