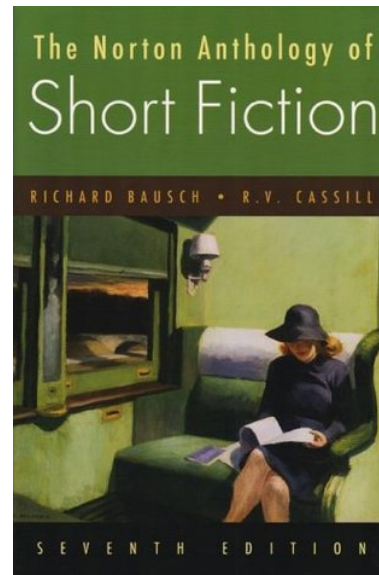

VISTAS is again conducting a seminar to discuss short stories written by acclaimed writers. Each session will involve group discussion of three or four short stories from an anthology. Participants read the stories prior to the meeting and then take part in the discussion during the meeting.

The stories chosen for discussion are contained in *The Norton Anthology of Short Fiction, Seventh Edition* (ISBN 0-393-92611-7). None of the stories selected for discussion will have been discussed in prior VISTAS seminars. We expect that this anthology will be used again in future seminars. Participants should obtain a copy of the collection in advance of the seminar. Used copies of the book are available at Amazon, Abebooks, and other internet used-book sellers.
