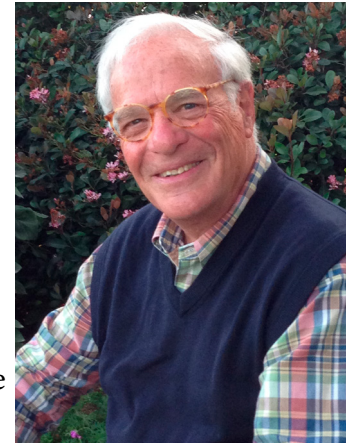

**BIOGRAPHY:** *Dr. David Bisno*, retired ophthalmologist with degrees from Harvard, Dartmouth and the Washington University School of Medicine, has been leading discussion groups on a myriad of topics within institutes for lifelong learning in this country and overseas for 22 years.



With his wife, Fay, in 1998, he was a founder of Santa Barbara’s VISTAS Institute for Lifelong Learning. Returning to Santa Barbara from New England, David captures our attention this year, first with this lecture and later in the winter with his eight week course: *The World of Yesterday*.

David studied constitutional law at the Harvard Law School with Professor Laurence Tribe and at the Law School of the College of William and Mary. He has honed well his ability to help lay audiences understand the complexities of constitutional law - the interpretation of “those wise restraints which make men free.”
