

David Wiesner and the Art of Wordless Storytelling

The Santa Barbara Museum of Art's exhibition *David Wiesner and the Art of Wordless Storytelling* is the first comprehensive retrospective of this internationally known master of the picture book and three-time winner of the prestigious Caldecott Medal.

This lecture will enhance our understanding of Wiesner's work by placing it in an arthistorical context, examining the many strands of influence in his approach to wordless storytelling. We'll learn how he uses multiple layers of watercolor to create opaque, exquisitely nuanced hues that bring each piece to life, from frogs flying on lily pads to a

giant turtle with a seashell village or vegetables floating in outer space. We'll also explore similarities of the dream imagery in Wiesner's books to the surrealists Dali, Ernst, and Magritte and will delve into the story-telling techniques of pioneering artists such as Lynd Ward and movies such as Stanley Kubrick's 2001: A Space Odyssey.
