### *Music at the Fin-de-Siècle Vienna... A Viennese Music Salon in Santa Barbara*

Vienna at the fin-de-siècle and all that went on within the Ringstrasse between 1889 and 1914!



Some of us remember the writers Kraus, Schnitzler and Zweig. No less memorable were the artists Klimt, Kokoschka and Schiele—and the musicians Strauss, Brahms, Mahler, Zemlinsky and Schoenberg. Then there was the Wittgenstein family, arguably the wealthiest, most talented, and eccentric in Europe. The family was held together by a fanatical love of music, yet torn apart by money, madness, conflicts of loyalty, and the cataclysmic upheaval of two world wars.

VISTAS Lifelong Learning and The Harvard Club of Santa Barbara will present an afternoon of music as if in the salon of Berta Zuckermandl at her palais on the Ringstrasse.

Dr. David Bisno, member of both the Harvard Club and VISTAS, will share with us the relatively unknown story of Paul Wittgenstein, the music lover who, after losing his right arm in WW I, went on to become the celebrated 'left handed pianist' enthralling all of Europe and America.
