

Raised in Santa Barbara during the 1950s, **Susan Miles Gulbransen** fondly recalls being taken by her mother to see the Santa Barbara Symphony at the Granada. She later became a high school teacher, Pan Am flight attendant, journalist (News-Press and Noozhawk), and ongoing volunteer. In the 1990s she helped make a new venue for art in Santa Barbara.

**Joan Rutkowski** was born into a musical family and became both an opera singer and a vocal teacher. She and her cellist husband traveled the world performing and teaching. She has served on the boards of multiple Santa Barbara performing groups. In 1993 her passion turned to forming a new venue, which eventually became the Granada Theatre we love today.
