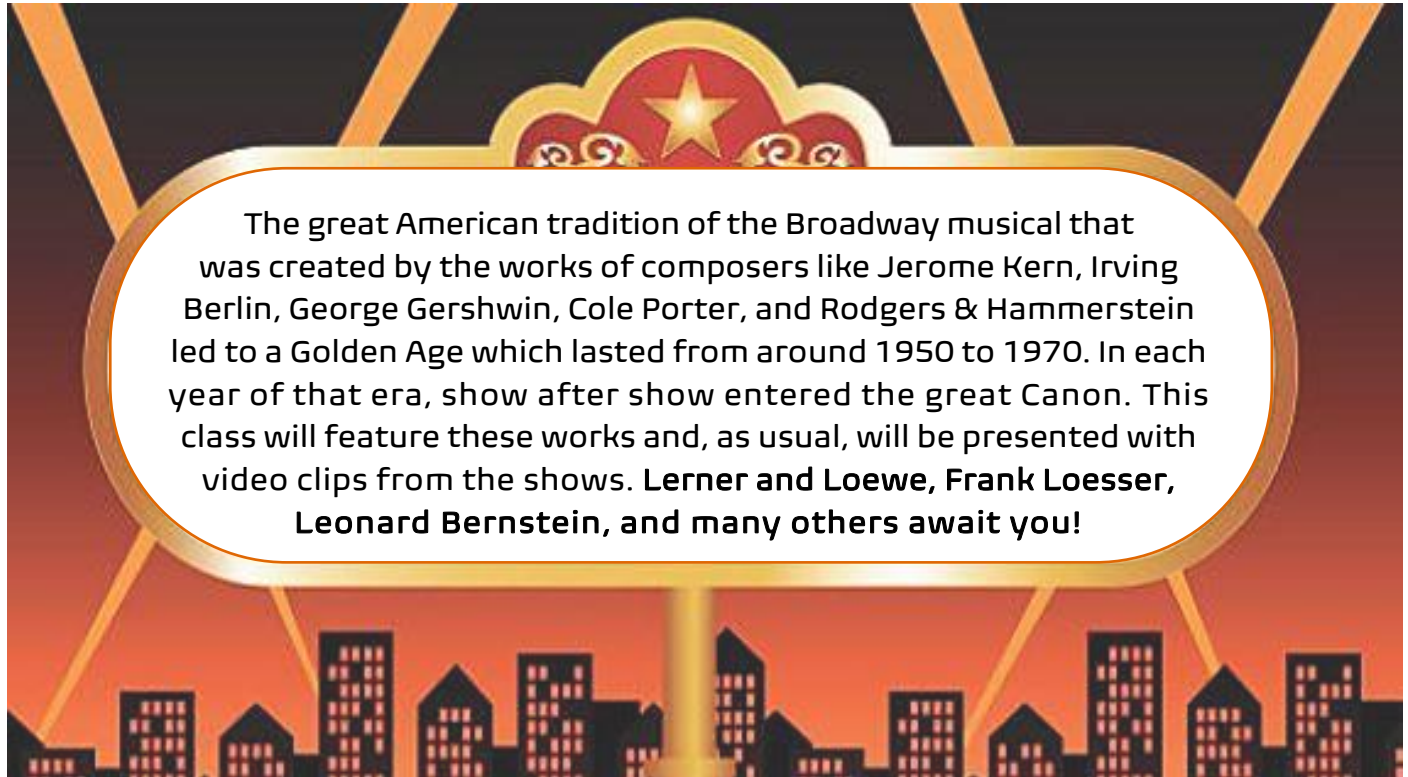

Dr. Weinman received a B.S. degree from Cornell Univ. in 1960 and a Ph.D. in theoretical physics from Caltech before pursuing postdoctoral studies in elementary particle theory at Tel Aviv University. He spent his entire career at Northrop, joining the company as a research scientist and later serving as a section manager for the MX missile program. He was awarded consecutive National Science Foundation and Westinghouse fellowships in the 1960s. Currently, he is a member of the board of directors of Opera Santa Barbara and of the Santa Barbara Symphony. Bob is one of our most popular presenters, whose classes typically focus on opera or Broadway and Hollywood musicals.
